

AN ORDINANCE NO. 752.

To Modify the Zoning Law.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY:

Section 1. That the zoning ordinance be modified in so far as it affects the property of Josephine Frommeyer and Frances Shook, being 50 x 150 feet out of the Northeast corner of Lot No. 10, on the plat of partition in the case of Miller vs. Joyce, Complete Record 96, page 515, known as No. 2303 - 2305 Sherwood Road; and said owners are hereby permitted to build a duplex house thereon, the west wall of which shall be Five (5) feet from the west property line.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
