ORDINANCE NO. 753.

To vecate part of the first alley south of Maryland Avenue and extending eastwardly from Sterwood Road.

WHEREAS, on the 22nd day of June, 1926, a petition and consent by the persons owning all the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon that part of the first alley south of Maryland Avenue extending eastwardly from Stanwood Road to the west line of the first alley east of Stanwood Road, a distance of approximately 21% feet, was duly presented to Council, praying that said alley between said points be vacated as provided in Section 3727 of the General Code, and

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for and that such vacation will not be detrimental to the general interests and finds that said petition and consent have been signed by all of the owners of lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said part of said alley, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDALIZED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE FILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That said first alley south of Maryland Avenue from Stanwood Read to the west line of the first alley east of Stanwood Read, being a distance of approximately 218 feet be, and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
