

AN ORDINANCE NO. 756.

By Mr. Pretzman.

Providing for repairing Parkview Avenue, Columbia Avenue and College Avenue in the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Parkview Avenue from a point approximately 100 feet north of the north line of Maryland Avenue to Main Street; Columbia Avenue from Commonwealth Park South to Bryden Road, and College Avenue from Main Street to Livingston Avenue in the Village of Bexley, shall be repaired by making the necessary repairs to the existing foundation, patching, paint and surface treating the same between the points hereinabove mentioned, in accordance with the specifications prepared by the engineer and on file with the Clerk, which specifications hereby are approved.

Section 2. That the Clerk be, and hereby is, authorized to advertise for bids for said improvement according to law and said Mayor and Clerk are authorized to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder therefor.

Section 3. That the cost of said improvement, estimated by the engineer at \$ 8000 shall be paid out of Maintenance and Repair of Street Fund.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


