AN ORDINANCE NO. 762.

Authorizing the Trustees of Public Affairs to enter into a contract for construction and laying down water main in South Remington Road.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs of the Village of Bexley be, and hereby are, authorized to enter into a contract, after due advertisement according to law, for the extension of the water works of the Village by laying down water main in South Remington Road from Fair Avenue to 1st, alley South of Fair to and From 1st, alley North of Sherwood to Main Street, and to proceed with said extension.

Section 2. That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the water fund for the payment of the cost of said water main, the estimated cost thereof in the sum of Three Thousand, Three Hundred Dollars (\$3,300.00).

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
