AMENDED APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE.

Section 1. Section 5. and the Village Clerk if hereby authorized to draw his warrants on the Village Treasurer for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefor, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same; or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. Provided further that the appropriation for "Contingent Fund" can only be expended for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the Village, and for purposes other than those covered by the other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
