

## AN ORDINANCE NO. 771.

To remit and cancel certain assessments upon premises in the Village of Bexley, belonging to the Board of Education of Bexley School District.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:



Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


