AN ORDINANCE NO. 783.

To extend Section 2 of all Ordinance No. 765, providing for the issue of bong in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of special assessments for the construction of sanitary sewer and pumping station in Sanitary Sewer District No. 6.

BE IS UPDA INED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 765, providing for the issue of bonds in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of special assements for the construction of sanitary sewer and pumping station; station in Sanitary Sewer District No. 6, passed on the 17th day of August 1926, be, and the same is amended to read as follows:

District No. 6 Exprovement donds," and serially numbered from one (1) to twenty-seven (27), note inclisive, They shall be of the denomination of \$1,000.00 each, except No. 27 which shall be \$200.00, bearing date of October 1st, 1926, and shall bear interest at the rate of five (5%) per cent per annum, payable semi-unnually on the first day of april and October each year, for which interest coupons bearing the fac simile signature of the Clerk, of said Village shall be attached to and made part thereof. Said bonds shall fall due and be payable in the order of their serial number as follows, to-wit:

flos. 1 to 5, inclusive, on October 1st, 1928.

" 6 to 10, " " " 1st, 1928.

" 11 to 15, " " " 1st, 1929.

" 16 to 21, " " " 1st, 1930.

" 22 to 27, " " " 1st, 1931.
