

ORDINANCE NO. 734.

To provide for alteration of the contract for the improvement of Denver Avenue.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 758, passed on the 13th day of July, 1926, Council determined to proceed with the improvement of Denver Avenue from Drexel Avenue to Ashbourne Road by grading, curbing and paving the roadway thereof with brick, asphalt, concrete or some other form of permanent improvement, and constructing sewers and water lines therein called for, and thereafter entered into a contract with The Burns Construction Company for said improvement wherein it was agreed to make said improvement with concrete of a certain mixture therein specified, and

WHEREAS, owing both to the nature of said mixture and the lateness of the season, Council has found it necessary and does hereby find it necessary for the purpose of obtaining a suitable and proper improvement, to alter and modify said contract so as to provide for an asphalt surface, and

WHEREAS, said The Burns Construction Company has agreed to construct said improvement with an asphalt surface on the following terms and conditions to-wit: Two Dollars and Sixty-five Cents (\$2.65) per square yard for the pavement laid, and One Dollar and Twenty-five Cents (\$1.25) per cubic yard for all excavating, same to be figured to a surface $8\frac{1}{2}$ inches below the finished asphalt surface, said street to have a 5 inch concrete base, 1-2 $\frac{1}{2}$ -5 mix, reinforcing steel to be used as provided for in concrete streets, and asphalt surface to be 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch asphalt surface according to Bexley specifications, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Council is of the opinion that it is necessary to alter and modify said contract for the improvement of Denver Avenue between the points hereinabove mentioned so as to provide for the substitution of an asphalt surface in place of the concrete surface called for in said contract, in the manner and upon the terms hereinabove set forth.

Section 2. Be it further ordained that the Mayor and Clerk be, and hereby are authorized, to enter into an agreement in writing with said The Burns Construction Company for the modification of said contract as hereinabove provided for.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from

and after the earliest period allowed by law.
