

AN ORDINANCE NO. 787.

To levy special assessments for the construction of sanitary sewers in part of Sanitary Sewer District No. 3.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of constructing sanitary sewers in part of Sanitary Sewer District No. 3 as follows, to-wit:

(a) An eight (8), ten (10) and twelve (12) inch sewer in Maryland Avenue from the present sanitary sewer in Stanbery Avenue to the first alley east of Ardmore Road.

(b) An eight (8) inch sewer in the first alley east of Ardmore Road from Maryland Avenue to a point 45 feet south of the south line of Ruhl Avenue.

(c) An eight (8) and ten (10) inch sewer in the first alley east of Cassady Road from Maryland Avenue to a point 15 feet north of the south line of Lot No. 463 Bellwood Addition.

(d) An eight (8) inch sewer in the first alley north of Ruhl Avenue from the first alley east of Cassady Avenue to a point 25 feet west of the west line of Spruce Street.

(e) An eight (8) inch sewer in the first alley north of Columbus Avenue from the first alley east of Cassady Avenue to a point 25 feet west of the west line of Spruce Street.

(f) An eight (8) inch sewer in the first alley north of Bellwood Avenue from the first alley east of Cassady Avenue to a point 25 feet west of the west line of Spruce Street.

(g) An eight (8) inch sewer in the first alley north of Allegheny Avenue from the first alley east of Cassady Avenue to a point 25 feet west of the west line of Spruce Street,

pursuant to and in accordance with an Ordinance No. 693, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed on the 23rd day of March, 1926, amounting in the aggregate to Sixteen Thousand, Seventy-five Dollars (\$16,075.00) as reported to this Council on the 23rd day of September, 1926, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of filing of which assessments has been given as required by law, be, and the same is hereby, adopted and confirmed; and that there be, and is hereby, levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, together with the description of said lots and lands are as follows, to-wit:

Notice of Sanitary Sewer Assessments.
 Notice is hereby given that the estimated assessments of the cost of constructing the following improvements:

(a) Sanitary sewer in Dawson Ave. from Maryland Ave. to Ruhl Ave.
 (b) Sanitary sewers in Maryland Ave., Walnut St., Caroline Ave. and in the alleys east of Drexel Ave., Walnut St. and Dawson Ave.
 (c) Sanitary sewers in Broad St., Stanwood Road, alley north of Broad St. and alley east of Remington Road.
 (d) Sanitary sewers in Maryland Ave., alley east of Cassady Road, alley east of Ardmore Road, and in the alleys north of Ruhl Ave., Columbus Ave., Bellwood Ave. and Allegheny Ave.

Upon the lots and lands benefited and to be charged therewith as set forth in resolutions to construct said sewers has been made and reported to council and said estimated assessments are now on file in the office of the clerk of the council of the village of Bexley, Ohio, for the inspection and examination of all persons interested therein.

And it is hereby determined and declared by this Council that said lots and lands are each benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment hereby levied thereon and that said assessments are in proportion to the special benefits.

Section 2. That the total assessments against each lot or parcel of land shall be paid in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this Ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in five annual installments, with interest at the rate of 5% per annum, from April 1st, 1927. All cash payments shall be made to the Treasurer of said Village. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
