

## AN ORDINANCE NO. 788

To levy special assessments for the construction of sanitary sewers in part of Sanitary Sewer District No. 3.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of constructing sanitary sewers in part of Sanitary Sewer District No. 3 as follows, to-wit:

An eight (8) inch sewer in Dawson Avenue with necessary house connections, between Maryland Avenue and Ruhl Avenue, pursuant to and in accordance with an Ordinance No. 707, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed on the 23rd, day of March, 1926, amounting in the aggregate to One Thousand, Seven Hundred Dollars (\$1,700.00) as reported to this Council on the 23rd day of September, 1926, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of filing of which assessments has been given as required by law, be and the same is hereby, adopted and confirmed; and that there be, and is hereby, levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvements, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which said assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands are as follows, to-wit:

And it is hereby determined and declared by this Council that said lots and lands are each benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessments hereby levied thereon and that said assessments are in proportion to the special benefits.

Section 2. That the total assessments against each lot or parcel of land shall be paid in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this Ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in five annual installments, with interest at the rate of 5% per annum, from April 1st, 1927. All cash payments shall be made to the Treasurer of said Village. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk to the

Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law to be by him placed upon the tax Duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**Notice of Sanitary Sewer Assessments.**

Notice is hereby given that the estimated assessments of the cost of constructing the following improvements:
