

## ORDINANCE NO. 602.

To amend Ordinance No. 602, "To fix the salaries, compensation, and bonds of Village Officials and employees, etc.", passed November 24, 1925.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Beasley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That ordinance No. 602, "To fix the salaries, compensation and bonds of Village Officials and employees, etc.", passed November 24, 1925, be amended as follows:

"Section 5. That the salary of the Building Inspector shall be Two Thousand Two Hundred and Twenty Dollars (\$2,420.00) per annum.

Section 3. That the salary of the Street Commissioner shall be Two Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$2,650.00) per annum; that the compensation of one Assistant Street Commissioner shall be at the rate of Seventeen Hundred and Forty Dollars (\$1,740.00) per annum while continuously employed; the compensation of common laborers shall be not to exceed Sixty-five cents (.65c.) per hour; the compensation for each team and driver employed by said Street Commissioner shall be not to exceed One Dollar (\$1.00) per hour; said Street Commissioner shall give bond in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

"Section 10. There shall be a clerk of the Trustees of the Sinking Fund and his salary Eight Hundred Forty Dollars (\$840.00) per annum. He shall give bond in the sum of Twenty-five thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$25,500.00) as provided by law."

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
