Accepting the bid of The Herrick Company, Cleveland, Ohio, for the Forty-six Thousand, and Twenty-five Dollars (\$46,025.00), par value of assessment bonds issued for the construction of sanitary sewers in the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That the bid of The Herrick Company, Cleveland, Ohio, for the Forty-six Thousand, and Twenty-five Dollars (\$46,025.00), par value of assessment bonds as follows, to-wit:
