

RESOLUTION NO. 648.

Appointing a board to report estimated assessment to pay the cost and expense of certain improvements in the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by Council to assess the whole cost, less one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof and the cost of intersections, of the construction and installation of a system for lighting certain streets and avenues in the Village of Bexley, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by Council to assess the followingt, percentages of that part of the cost of improveing certain streets and avenues in the Village of Bexley, by constructing water mains therein with necessary fir hydrants and connecting same with existing mains in the Village of Bexley and City of Columbus; to-wit: 20% thereof upon all the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon the north side of Maryland Avenue between Drexel Avenue and the east corporation line and on the south side of Maryland Avenue between the east line of Bullitt Park East Addition and the east corporation line; 50% thereof upon all the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon the west side of Gould Road from Maryland Avenue to Main Street; 10.5% thereof upon all the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon the south side of Main Street between the east corporation line and Chelsea Avenue; 10.5% thereof upon all the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting on the west side of Chelsea Avenue from Mound Street to Main Street and on the east side of Chelsea Avenue from the north line of Lot Number Sixteen (16) of Drake's East Lawn Annex Addition to Main Street, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That C. E. Underwood, W. R. Edmister and R. L. Phelps, three disinterested free holders of the Village be, and they are hereby appointed a board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith as set forth in the ordinance hereinabove mentioned providing for said improvements in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from the improvements to the several lots or parcels of land so assessed and to report to this council the said estimates assessment.
