

RESOLUTION NO. 652.

To provide for lighting Meadow Park Avenue in the Village of Bexley and for levying and collecting special assessments therefor.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it is hereby declared to be necessary to provide for lighting Meadow Park Avenue in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, by laying underground cables, erecting light standards, installing lamps, conduits and other necessary equipment, in accordance with the plans, specifications and estimates for said system of lighting now on file in the office of the Village Clerk, which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That in accordance with the petition filed with Council, asking for said improvement, wherein the signers agreed to pay the entire cost of said improvement, the entire cost of constructing and installing said system for lighting said street shall be specially assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement on all the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon said street, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement and in an amount equal to that part of the cost thereof hereby determined to be assessed thereon.

Section 3. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in five equal annual installments with interest on the deferred payments at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be hereafter issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of such assessments.

Section 4. That bonds of said village shall be issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of said assessments, in an amount sufficient to pay the estimated cost of said improvement.

Section 5. That notice of the adoption of this resolution shall be given to the owners of the lots and lands to be assessed for the payment of the cost and expense of such lighting, by publication thereof in a newspaper printed in Ohio and of general circulation in the village, for the period of fifteen days prior to the taking effect thereof.

Section 6. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
