

RESOLUTION NO. 655.

Appointing board to report estimated assessments to pay the cost and expense of certain improvement hereinafter set forth.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by Council to assess that part of the cost hereinafter designated of those certain improvements hereinafter set forth in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement, NOW, THEREFORE: BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That C. E. Underwood, R. L. Phelps and Dr. E. C. Mills three disinterested free-holders of said Village be, and they are hereby, appointed a board to estimate the assessment of such cost and expenses on the lots and lands to be charged therewith as set forth in the respective ordinances determining to proceed with said improvements in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from said improvements to the several lots or parcels of land so assessed and to report to this Council said estimated assessments, Said improvements with said respective ordinances and proportion of cost to be assessed being as follows, to-wit:

Drexel Avenue from Maryland Avenue to Caroline Avenue, Ordinance No. 704, passed March 23rd, 1926, one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof less the cost of intersections.

Columbia Avenue from Caroline Avenue to Delmar Drive, Ordinance No. 824, passed March 15th, 1927, one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof less the cost of intersections.

Dawson Avenue from Maryland Avenue to Ruhl Avenue, Ordinance No. 826, passed March 15th, 1927, one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof less the cost of intersections.

Walnut Street from Maryland Avenue to Delmar Drive, Ordinance No. 825, passed March 15th, 1927, one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof less the cost of intersections.

Drexel Avenue from Caroline Avenue to Delmar Drive, Ordinance No. 823, passed March 15th, 1927, one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof less the cost of intersections.

Grandon Avenue from Livingston Avenue to Main Street, Ordinance No. 827, passed March 15th, 1927, one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof less the cost of intersections.

Maryland Avenue from Drexel Avenue to Cassady Road, Ordinance No. 828, passed March 15th, 1927, one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof less the cost of intersections.

Sherwood Road from Drexel Avenue to Remington Road, Ordinance No. 829, passed March 15th, 1927, one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof less the cost of intersections.

Allegheny Avenue from Cassady Road to Spruce Street, Ordinance No. 830, passed March 15th, 1927, one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof less the cost of intersections.

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Bryden Road from Cassady Road to Remington Road, Ordinance No. 843, passed March 25th, 1927, one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof, less the cost of intersections.

Boston Avenue from Columbia Avenue to Drexel Avenue, Ordinance No. 864, passed June 14th, 1927, the entire cost of said improvement.

Montrose Avenue from Livingston Avenue to Charles Street, Ordinance No. 761, passed July 13th, 1926, the entire cost of said improvement.

Cassingham Road from Livingston Avenue to Charles Street, Ordinance No. 759, passed July 13th, 1926, the entire cost of said improvement.

Remington Road from Maryland Avenue to Ruhl Avenue, by constructing a six (6) inch water line, Ordinance No. --- passed April 28th, 1927, less two percent (2%) of the cost thereof.


Ruhl Avenue from Cassingham Road to the east corporation line, by constructing a six (6) inch water line, Ordinance No. 855, passed April 28th, 1927, less two percent (2%) of the cost thereof.


Westland Avenue from Fair Avenue to Park Hill Drive and Park Hill Drive from Westland Avenue to Park Drive, by constructing a six (6) inch water line, Ordinance No. 839, passed March 15th, 1927, less two percent (2%) of the cost thereof.

Construction of a main drain or sewer in Clifton Avenue, in accordance with Ordinance No. 854, passed April 28th, 1927, the cost thereof less one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof and less the amount to be assessed against the Columbus Commons.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
