

RESOLUTION NO. 664.

By Mr. Manly.

Providing for the construction of sidewalks on Cassingham Road from Broad Street to Fair Avenue.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That a sidewalk shall be constructed on each side of Cassingham Road from Broad Street to Fair Avenue in the Village of Bexley of the character and in the manner following: Said sidewalks shall be constructed of concrete in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor, heretofore adopted by Council and now on file in the office of the Village Clerk; it shall be five (5) feet in width with a cross slope of $\frac{3}{8}$ ths of an inch per foot and shall be placed with the inside edge, (being the edge next to the lot line) 11 feet from the back edge of the curb.

The inside edge, or edge next to the lot line, shall be parallel with and 6 inches above the grade of the curb.

The foot of the terrace slope shall not extend into the street beyond the property line.

Section 2. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety by reason of the fact that the new grade school has opened its term, and the traffic congestion is such that the lives of the school children are placed in great danger in going to and from school, as they must, in the absence of sidewalks, walk in the street.

Section 3. That the Clerk of Council be, and he is hereby, directed to cause a written notice of the passage of this Resolution to be served as required by law.

Section 4. This resolution shall go into immediate force and effect.
