

RESOLUTION NO. 665.

Providing for the repair of Fair Avenue opposite Cassingham Road.
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Fair Avenue opposite the extension of Cassingham Road northerly therefrom, be repaired by cutting through the parkway therein and repairing and improving same by laying concrete foundation and asphalt surface and necessary curbing to conform with the present roadway of Fair Avenue, in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the Village engineers and on file in the office of the Clerk, which plans and specifications are hereby approved.

Section 2. Be it further resolved, that the cost of said improvement be paid out of the street repair fund of said Village and, whereas, it is estimated same will cost \$1100.00 said sum of \$1100.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of said fund for said purpose.

Section 3. WHEREAS, an emergency exists rendering this measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public safety in that the opening of the public school on Cassingham Road has so congested traffic at this point that the lives of many school children are imperiled and the above repair will relieve said situation, this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall go into effect immediately upon its passage.

Section 4. The Clerk is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the above repair, in accordance with the statute and, together with the Mayor, to enter into a contract for said work.
