

RESOLUTION NO. 670.

Granting permission to The Ohio Safety Gate Company, with its principal office at Columbus, Ohio, to install two automatic safety highway gates on College Avenue at the crossing of the Southern Ohio Public Service Company in the Village of Bexley.

WHEREAS, a request has been received from The Ohio Safety Gate Company that a permit be granted for the erection of two automatic safety highway gates on College Avenue at the crossing of the Southern Ohio Public Service Company upon order issued by the Ohio Highway Safety Company co-operating with the State Highway and Public Utilities Commissions for experimental and display purposes, and

WHEREAS, Council is of the opinion that said permit should be granted subject to the terms and conditions herein contained, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That a permit be and hereby is granted to The Ohio Safety Gate Company, of Columbus, Ohio, to install two automatic safety highway gates on College Avenue at the crossing of the Southern Ohio Public Service Company in the following manner, to-wit: The foundation for the north gate, which foundation will be about 3' x 5' in area dimensions, is to be placed on the east side of College Avenue between the curb and sidewalk about six feet north of the storm sewer inlet. The foundation for the snubber mechanism of this gate will be placed between the sidewalk and curb on the opposite side of College Avenue, from the gate foundation. The foundation for the south gate (same dimensions as above) is to be placed between the curb and sidewalk on the west side of College Avenue at a point 27' to 32' south of the point where the south rail of the above electric road crosses the west curb of College Avenue. The foundation for the snubber mechanism for the south gate is to be placed on the east side of College Avenue at a point opposite to the gate foundation. The total distance measured between the centers of the road arms on these two gates will be approximately 76' 4".

Section 2. That said installation shall be without cost or obligation to the Village of Bexley and whereas, same is for the purpose of experimentation and display, said The Ohio Safety Gate Company shall indemnify the Village of Bexley against any loss or damage occasioned to person or property by reason of said installation or maintenance of said gates and shall furnish bond to said Village for


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that purpose to the satisfaction of council, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).

Section 3. Said gates may be removed by said The Ohio Safety Gate Company at its pleasure and shall be removed forthwith upon notice from the Council of said Village of Bexley.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
