

RESOLUTION NO. 686.

Appointing a board to report estimated assessments to pay the cost and expense of certain improvements in the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by Council to assess the whole cost of the construction and installation of a system for lighting Meadow Park Avenue in the Village of Bexley, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by Council to assess the whole cost of the construction of sidewalks on Cassingham Road from Broad Street to Fair Avenue, except the cost of intersections, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That C. E. Underwood, Ray. L. Phelps and Dr. E. C. Mills, three disinterested freeholders of said Village be, and they are hereby, appointed a board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith as set forth in the respective ordinances or resolutions determining to proceed with said improvements in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from said improvements to the several lots and parcels of land so assessed and to report to this council said estimated assessment.
