

ORDINANCE NO. 810.

To vacate Elm Avenue between the west line of Parkview Avenue and the east line of Westland Avenue in the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

WHEREAS, on the 21st day of February, 1927, a petition by the persons owning all the lots and lands abutting upon that part of Elm Avenue lying between the west line of Parkview Avenue and the east line of Westland Avenue in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, was duly presented to Council, praying that said part of said avenue be vacated, and

WHEREAS, all of said owners of property abutting upon said part of Elm Avenue hereinabove described have consented in writing that the same be vacated, and

WHEREAS, council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for said vacation as prayed for and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and that same ought to be vacated, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That that part of Elm Avenue lying between the west line of Parkview Avenue and the east line of Westland Avenue be, and the same is hereby, vacated.

Section 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

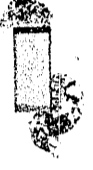
