

AN ORDINANCE NO. 841.

Granting permission to W. S. McDowell to tap into water line in Westland Avenue south of Fair Avenue.

WHEREAS, W. S. McDowell, the owner of a tract of land on the west side of Westland Avenue, 62½ feet in width and 100 feet in depth, the north side of which tract is 175 feet south of Fair Avenue has petitioned for permission to tap into the water line which was constructed in Westland Avenue by S. L. and Louise K. Haynes and B. B. Paddock for the service of their premises on the east side of Westland Avenue, and has obtained the consent in writing of said Haynes and Paddock to tap into said water line, for the service of his said premises on the west side of Westland Avenue as above described, and has signed in writing a waiver on behalf of himself, his heirs and assigns, agreeing with the Village that when a water line shall be constructed by the Village in Westland Avenue that said premises may be assessed for its proper proportion of the cost of said water line and therein waived the right to claim exemption from such assessment on the ground that said premises already have or may have adequate water service, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That said W. S. McDowell in consideration of said waiver and of said agreement, is hereby granted permission to tap into said water line now so located in Westland Avenue south of Fair Avenue, for the supply of water to the premises hereinabove described and to lay at his own expense and under the supervision of the Board of Public Affairs of the Village of Bexley, the necessary water line to connect said premises to said line in Westland Avenue, the permission to so tap to be secured by the said W. S. McDowell, and said construction to be made and maintained without cost to the Village.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


