## AN ORDINANCE NO. 875.

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Ruhl Avenue from Cassingham Road to the east corporation line of the Village of Bexley, by constructing a six (6) inch water line therein.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That he assessment of the cost and expense of improving Ruhl avenue from Cassingham Road to the east correlation line of the Village of Bexley, by constructing a six (6) inch water line therein, pursuant to and in accordance with an Ordinance No. 855, passed April 28th, 1927, amounting in the aggregate to Sixteen Hundred Dollars (\$1600.00), as reported to this Council on the 8th day of September, 1927, by the Board heratofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of filing of which assessment has been given as required by law, be, and the same is hereby, adopted and confirmed; and that there be, and is hereby, levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding am abutting upon said improvements, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which said assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands are as follows, to-wit:

and it is nereby determined and declared by this Council that said lots and lands are each benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment hereby levied thereon and that said assessments are in proportion to the special benefits.

Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be paid in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in five annual installments, within interest at the rate of 5% per annum, from December

lst, 1927. All cash payments shall be made to the Treasurer of said Village. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection as other toward one collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and a in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
