

## ORDINANCE NO. 884.

Accepting deed of easement of Robert H. Jeffrey for sewer purposes.

WHEREAS, Robert H. Jeffrey has executed his deed of easement to the Village of Bexley and through the following described premises in said Village of Bexley, Ohio, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the north line of Clifton Avenue, said point being approximately 1525 feet west of the west line of Parkview Avenue; thence westerly for a distance of 150 feet to a point, said point being 7 feet north of the north line of Clifton Avenue; thence westerly, parallel to and 7 feet distant from the north line of Clifton Avenue, to the center line of Alum Creek,

for the purpose of constructing a thirty-three (33) and thirty-six (36) inch storm sewer therein and entering thereon for the purpose of repairing and maintaining same, using only so much land upon each side of said above described line as may be necessary for that purpose, and

WHEREAS, it will be for the best interest of the Village to accept said conveyance, NOW, THEREFORE:


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That the deed of said Robert H. Jeffrey, bearing date of June 29, 1927, conveying to the Village of Bexley a right of way and easement in and through the above described premises for sewer purposes be, and the same is hereby, accepted and the clerk is hereby directed to certify upon said deed, and acceptance thereof by Council and to file same for record in the Recorder's office of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
