AN ORDINANCE NO. 887.

Providing for entering into an agreement with the City of Columbus for fire protection for period ending December 31st, 1930.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

section 1. That the Mayor and Clerk be, and hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract on benalf of the Village of Bexley, with the City of Columbus, Ohio, providing for fire protection to said Village for the period ending December 31st, 1950, and modifying the existing contract between said City and said Village so as to provide that the service remarred and to be rendered during the year 1927, shall be paid for by said Village in the sum of Eleven Thousand Dollars (#11,000.00) and that said service during the succeeding years shall be paid for by said Village at the following rents: 1928, Eleven Thousand Dollars (#11,000.00); 1929, Twelve Thousand Dollars (#12,000.00), and 1930, Thirteen Thousand Dollars (#13,000.00) and that said contract shall contain such other reasonable and proper provisions as may be necessary for the carrying into effect thereof and for the furnishing of said service to the Village.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
