

AN ORDINANCE NO. 892.

By Mr. Manly.

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Bryden Road from Cassady Road to Remington Road.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving Bryden Road from Cassady Road to Remington Road, by grading, curbing and paving the roadway thereof with asphalt, constructing the necessary sewers or drains and erecting street signs, pursuant to and in accordance with Ordinance No. 843, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed by Council on the 25th day of March, 1927, in the aggregate amount of Nineteen Thousand, Three Hundred Dollars (\$19,300.00) as reported to this Council on the 9th day of November, 1927, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of filing of which assessments has been given as required by law be, and the same is hereby adopted and confirmed; and that there be, and is hereby, levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which said assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands, are as follows, to-wit:

And it is hereby determined and declared by this Council that said lots and lands are each benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment hereby levied thereon and that said assessments are in proportion to the special benefits.

Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be paid in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in nine annual installments with interest at the rate of % per annum, from April 1st, 1928. All cash payments shall be made to the Treasurer of said Village. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
