

ORDINANCE NO. 894.

By Mr. Bonnet,

Providing for the acceptance of the improvement of Ardmore Road from Maryland Avenue to Ruhl Avenue and payment of the final estimate thereon.

WHEREAS, The A. W. Burns Construction Company has fully performed and completed its contract for the improvement of Ardmore Road and is entitled to the payment of the final estimate thereon, and

WHEREAS, certain damage has been done to a portion of said improvement by The Yale Avenue Construction Company under its contract for the improvement of Ruhl Avenue by reason whereof the Village has withheld the acceptance of said improvement of Ardmore Road, and

WHEREAS, the Globe Indemnity Company, as representing The Yale Avenue Construction Company has filed with the Council, its acknowledgment of responsibility for said damage, and

WHEREAS, said damage can not be repaired until the spring of the year and Council is of the opinion that the final acceptance of said improvement should not be delayed until that time, NOW, THEREFORE:


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the improvement of Ardmore Road be accepted and the final estimate paid thereon to The A. W. Burns Construction Company.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
