

RESOLUTION NO. 692.

Resolution -As to offer of bonds, to the Retirement Board of the State Teachers Retirement System.

Date of meeting January 10 1928.

Mr. Sam'l Betz, offered the following Resolution.

Resolved: That the Clerk of the Village of Bexley is hereby authorized and directed to offer to the Retirement Board of the State Teachers Retirement System, an issue of bonds of the Village of Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio, in the sum of Ten Thousand, Three Hundred Dollars, (\$10,300.00), dated October 1, 1927, and bearing interest at the rate of 4 1/2% per cent per annum payable April 1, and October 1, at par, accrued interest to date of delivery, and a premium of Sixty Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$60.50), which is hereby declared by said Village of Bexley to be a fair price market value for said bonds.

Said bonds are issued in accordance with an Ordinance of the Village of Bexley passed on September 6, 1927, under authority of the General Laws of the State of Ohio, particularly Sec. \_\_\_\_\_ of the General Code of Ohio, for the purpose of improving Denver Avenue from Drexel Avenue to Ashbourne Road by grading, curbing and paving the roadway thereof with asphalt, constructing water lines and erecting signs.
