RESOLUTION NO. 697.

By Mr. Manly.

Declaring it necessary to improve Havenwood Drive from Euclaire Avenue to Cassingham Road.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEDLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it is necessary to improve Havenwood Drive from Euclaire Avenue to Cassingham Road, by grading, curbing and paving the roadway thereof with brick, asphalt, concrete or some other form of permanent improvement, constructing the necessary sewers or drains to furnish proper drainage for said improvement and erecting street signs, also constructing sidewalks on the south side of said drive, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles heretofore filed with this Council which are hereby approved.

shall be the Grade shown by and upon the plans and profiles aforesaid and the grade of the curbs shall be as follows; to-wit:

SOUTH CURB-

Beginning at the east property line of Euclaire avenue, Station 0.00, and elevation 96.40; thence easterly with a 1.00% ascending grade to Station 0.50 and elevation 96.90; thence easterly with a 0.60% ascending grade to Station 2.40 and elevation 98.04; thence easterly with a 0.44% descending grade to the west property line of Cassingnam Road, Station 3.07.5 and elevation 97.74.

NORTH CURB-

The elevation of the north curb to be the same as that of the south curb.

The above elevations refer to Village Datum.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement, less 1/50th of the cost of sidwwalks and less the cost of intersections, and one-half of the remainder of said costs shall be specially assessed

in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit: All of the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon said improvement, which lots and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefited by said improvement and in the amount equal to that part of the cost hereof hereby determined to be assessed thereon.

Section 4. That the special assessments so to be levied small be

paid in not less than nine or more than ten equal annual installments with interest on the deferred payments at the same rate as shall be horne by the bonds to be hereadter issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessments.

Section 5. That said Village may borrow money and issue notes due and payable not later than two years from date of issue, in anticipation of the levy of said assessments and of the issuance of bonds in anticipation of the collection of said special assessments as provided in Section 2295-24 of the General Code of Onio, said notes shall not exceed in amount that portion of the estimated cost of the improvement for which said assessments are to be levied.

Section 6. That bonds of said Village shall be issued, in anticipation of the collection of said assessments, in an amount sufficient to pay that portion of the estimated cost of said improvement hereinbefore determined to be assessed upon the property fronting and abutting thereon.

Section 7. That the village's portion of the cost of said improvement shall be paid from the proceeds of bonds, issued by said villagein the manner provided by law.

Section 8. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the parliest period allowed by law.
