RESOLUTION NO. 704.

Declaring it necessary to widen the roadway of Fair Avenue at the intersection thereof with Drexel Avenue.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it is necessary to widen the roadway of Fair Avenue at the intersection of Drexel Avenue, to the width of approximately sixty-two (62) feet by resetting the curbing, grading, paving the roadway thereof with asphalt and making the necessary changes in drains for said improvement in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles heretofore prepared by the Village Engineer and on file with this Council, which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That the whole cost of said improvement shall be paid by the Village from the proceeds of bonds issued by said Village in the manner provided by law.

Section 5. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the carliest period allowed by law.
