

RESOLUTION NO. 719.

Rejecting bids for certain improvements within the Village of Bexley and directing the Clerk to re-advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the advertisement for bids for the improvement of the following streets, road and avenues, to-wit: Havenwood Drive from Euclaire Avenue to Cassingham Road; Cassady Road from Sherwood Road to Brentwood Road; Elm Avenue from Parkview Avenue to Columbia Avenue, and from Cassady Road to Remington Road; Remington Road from Elm Avenue to Powell Avenue, and the widening and repair of Fair Avenue at the intersection of Drexel Avenue, certain bids were received on the 1st, day of May, 1928, and opened pursuant to law, and

WHEREAS, Council is of the opinion that the best interests of the Village require that all of said bids be rejected, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That all bids heretofore received for the foregoing improvements be, and the same are hereby, rejected.

Section 2. Be it further resolved that the Clerk be, and he is hereby directed to re-advertise for bids for the construction of said improvements according to law.
