

RESOLUTION NO. 720.

To amend Resolution No. 713, providing for lighting certain streets in the Village of Bexley.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That paragraphs j and k of Section 1 of Resolution No. 713, providing for lighting certain streets in the Village of Bexley, adopted April 10th, 1928, be, and the same are hereby amended to read as follows:

(j) Cassingham Road from Main Street to Livingston Avenue.

(k) Montrose Avenue from Main Street to Livingston Avenue.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.




