RESOLUTION NO. 728.

Appointing board to report estimated assessments to pay
the cost and expense of certain improvements hereinafter set forth.

WHEREAS: It has been determined by Council to assess that
part of the cost hereinafter designated of those certain improvements
set forth in proportion to the benefits which may result from said
improvements, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. ThatC. E. Underwood, R. L. Phelps and Pr. E. C. Mills, three disinterested free-holders of said Village be, and they are hereby, appointed a Board to estimate the assessment of such cost and expenses on the lots and lands to be charged therewith as set forth in the respective ordinances determining to proceed with said improvements in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from said improvements to the several lots or parcels of land so assessed and to report to this council said estimated assessments, said improvements with said respective ordinances and proportion of cost to be assessed being as follows, to-wit:

Cassady Road from Sherwood to Brentwood Road, Ordinance No. 921, passed February 28, 1928, the entire cost of said improvement less One-third (1/3) thereof and the cost of intersections.

Cassingham Road from Main Street to Fair Avenue, Ordinance No. 923, passed February 28, 1928, the entire cost of said improvement, less one-third (1/3) thereof and the cost of intersections.

Havenwood Drive from Enclaire Avenue to Cassingham Road, Ordinance No. 926, passed February 28, 1928, the entire cost of said improvement, less one-fiftieth (1/50) of the cost of sidewalks and less the cost of intersections and $\frac{1}{2}$ of the remainder of said cost.

Dawson Avenue from Main Street to Fair Avenue, Ordinance No. 929, passed March 13, 1928, the entire cost of said improvement, less one-third (1/3) thereof and the cost of intersections.

Remington Road from Powell Avenue to Elm Avenue, Ordinance No. 945, passed April 10, 1928, the entire cost of said improvement, less one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof and the cost of intersections and less the cost of widening said road between the points mentioned.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in

force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
