

RESOLUTION NO. 756.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BENLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That sidewalks shall be constructed on both sides of Columbia Avenue from Bryden Road to Broad Street, of the character and in the manner following: Said sidewalks shall be constructed of concrete in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor, heretofore adopted by Council and now on file in the office of the Village Clerk; ~~it~~ shall be five (5) feet in width with a cross slope of $\frac{3}{8}$ th of an inch per foot and shall be placed with the inside edge, being the edge next to the lot line, eighteen (18) feet from the curb line.

The grade of the inside edge, or edge next to the lot line, shall be as follows:

EAST SIDE:

Between Station 0+00 (the north line of Bryden Road) and Station 3+00 the walk shall be 11 inches above the curb; between Station 3+00 and Station 4+50 the walk shall vary in height above the curb from 11 inches at Station 3+00 to 17 inches at Station 4+50; between Station 4+50 and Station 5+50 the walk shall vary in height above the curb from 17 inches at Station 4+50 to 7 inches at Station 5+50; between Station 5+50 and Station 12+00 the walk shall be 7 inches above the curb; between Station 12+00 and Station 14+00 the walk shall vary in height above the curb from 7 inches at Station 12+00 to 15 inches at Station 14+00; between Station 14+00 and Station 16+00 the walk shall be 15 inches above the curb; between Station 16+00 and 17+82 (the south line of Dale Avenue) the walk shall vary in height above the curb from 13 inches at Station 16+00 to 7 inches at Station 17+82; between Station 18+32 (the north line of Dale Avenue) and Station 23+33 (the south line of Elm Avenue) the walk shall be 8 inches above the curb; between Station 23+73 (the north line of Elm Avenue) and Station 28+73 (the south line of Powell Avenue) the walk shall be 10 inches above the curb; between Station 29+13 (the north line of Powell Avenue) and Station 34+00 the walk shall be 10 inches above the curb; between Station 34+00 and Station 35+91 (the south line of Broad Street) the walk shall vary in height above the curb from 10 inches at Station 34+00 to 6 inches at Station 35+91 (the south line of Broad Street).

WEST SIDE.

Between Station 0+00 (the north line of Bryden Road) and Station 7+00 the walk shall be 4 inches above the curb; at Station 7+50 the walk shall be 5 inches above the curb; between Station 7+50 and Station 13+00 the walk shall be 5 inches above the curb; between Station 13+00 and Station 14+50 the walk shall vary in height above the curb from 5 inches at Station 13+00 to 10 inches at Station 14+50; between Station 14+50 and Station 16+50 the walk shall vary in height above the curb from 10 inches at Station 14+50 to 6 inches at Station 16+50; between Station 16+50 and Station 17+82 (the south line of Dale Avenue) the walk shall be 6 inches above the curb; between Station 18+32 (the north line of Dale Avenue) and Station 19+50 the walk shall vary in height above the curb from 5 inches at Station 18+32 to 9 inches at Station 19+50; between Station 19+50 and Station 23+33 (the south line of Elm Avenue) the walk shall be 9 inches above the curb; between Station 23+73 (the north line of Elm Avenue) and Station 28+73 (the south line of Powell Avenue) the walk shall be 9 inches above the curb; between Station 29+13 (the north

line of Powell Avenue) and Station 32+00 the walk shall be 7 inches above the curb; at Station 32+50 the walk shall be 9 inches above the curb; between Station 32+50 and Station 35+91 (the south line of Broad Street) the walk shall be 9 inches above the curb.

The foot of the terrace slope shall not extend into the street beyond the property line.

That the Clerk of Council be, and he is hereby, directed to cause a written notice of the passage of this Resolution to be served as required by law.
