

RESOLUTION NO. 740.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That sidewalks shall be constructed on both sides of Cassady Avenue between Brentwood Road and Broad Street, and between Main Street and Sherwood Road, of the character and in the manner following, to-wit:

Said sidewalks between Brentwood Road and Broad Street shall be constructed of concrete, in accordance with the general plans and specifications for sidewalks heretofore adopted by Council and now on file, and in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 378, duly passed October 19th, 1922. Said sidewalks shall be 5 feet in width with a cross slope of $\frac{3}{8}$ th of an inch per foot, with the foot of the terrace slope not nearer than 1 foot to the inside edge of the walk (or the edge next to the lot line). Said sidewalks between the points above mentioned shall be located as follows: From the north line of Brentwood Road to the south line of Fair Avenue said walks shall be constructed with the inside edge (or edge next to the lot line) $23\frac{1}{2}$ feet from the back of the curb; from the north line of Fair Avenue to the south line of Broad Street, the inside edge shall be $13\frac{1}{2}$ feet from the back edge of the curb.

The grade of the inside edge of said sidewalk between said points, shall be as follows: From the north line of Brentwood Road to the south line of Fair Avenue, the inside edge of the sidewalks shall be ten inches above the curb and shall run parallel therewith; from the north line of Fair Avenue to the south line of Broad Street the inside edge of the sidewalks shall be 6 inches above the curb and shall run parallel therewith.

Said sidewalks between Main Street and Sherwood Road shall be constructed of concrete, in accordance with the general plans and specifications for sidewalks heretofore adopted by Council of the Village and shall be 4 feet in width with a cross slope of $\frac{3}{8}$ ths of an inch per foot and shall be placed with the inside edge, being the edge next to the lot line, 10 feet from the back edge of the curb and 5 inches above the same.

The foot of the terrace slope shall not extend into the street beyond the property line.

That the Clerk of Council be, and he is hereby, directed to cause a written notice of the passage of this resolution to be served as required by law.
