RESCLUTION NO. 746.

By Mr. Pretzman.

That sidewalks shall be constructed on both sides of Cassady

Avenue between Brentwood Road and Broad Street, and between Main

Street and Sherwood Road, of the character and in the manner following,

to-wit:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO;

That said sidewalks between Broad Street and Fair Avenue shall be constructed of concrete in accordance with the general plans and specifications for widewalks heretofore adopted by Council and now on file. Said side walks shall be 5 feet in width with a cross slope of 5/8ths of an inch per foot, with the inside edge (or edge next to the lot line) $13\frac{1}{5}$ feet from the back edge of the curb. The grade of the inside edge of said side walk between said points shall be 6 inches above the curb and shall run parallel therewith.

Said sidewalks between Prentwood Road and Fair Avenue and between Main Street and Sherwood Road shall be constructed of concrete, in accordance with the general plans and specifications for sidewalks heretofore adopted by Council of the Village and shall be 4 feet in width with a cross slope of 3/8ths of an inch per foot and shall be placed with whe inside edge, being the edge next to the lot line, 10 feet from the back edge of the curb and 5 inches above the same.

The foot of the terrace slope shall not extend into the street bey nd the property line.

That Resolution No. 740, passed September 25th, 1928, be and the same 10 hereby repealed.

That the Clark of Council be, and he is hereby, directed to cause a written notice of the passage of this resolution to be served as required by law.
