AN ORDINANCE NO. 899

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Dawson Avenue from Maryland Avenue to Ruhl Avenue and from Caroline Avenue to Delmar Drive.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Dawson avenue from Maryland avenue to Runl avenue and from Caroline avenue to Delmar Drive, by grading, curbing and paving the roadway thereof with asphalt, constructing necessary severs or drains—and erecting street signs, and a six (6) inch water line, pursuant to and in accordance with Ordinance No. 626, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed by Council on the 15th day of March, 1927, in the aggregate amount of seventeen Thousand, Three Hundred Dollars (\$17,300.00) as reported to this Council on the 22nd, day of November, 1927, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of filing of which assessments has been given as required by law be, and the same is hereby, adopted and confirmed; and that there be, and is hereby levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the averal amounts reported as aforesaid, which said assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands, are as follows, to-wit:
