AN ORDINANCE NO. 911.

To smend Section 3 of Ordinance No. 758, determining to proceed with the improvement of Denver Avenue from Drexel Avenue to Ashbourne Road.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE & ONIO:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 758, determining to proceed with the improvement of Denver Avenue from Drexel Avenue to Ashbourne Road, passed July 13th, 1926, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. That in accordance with the petition of the property owners heretofore filed herein, the whole cost of said improvement, less 4.63% thereof, shall be specially assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon the following lots and lands, to-wit: All of the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon said proposed improvement between the points aforesaid, which said lots and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefited by said improvement and in an amount equal to that part of the cost thereof hereby determined to be assessed thereon."

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
