

AN ORDINANCE NO. 917.

To levy special assessments for constructing a storm sewer in Clifton Avenue between Alum Creek and a point approximately 300 feet west of Parkview Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of constructing a storm sewer in Clifton Avenue between Alum Creek and a point approximately 300 feet west of Parkview Avenue, pursuant to and in accordance with Ordinance No. 854, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed by Council on the 28th day of April, 1927, in the aggregate amount of Nine Thousand Thirty-two Dollars (\$9,032.00) as reported to this Council on the 14th day of December, 1927, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of filing of which assessments has been given as required by law be, and the same is hereby, adopted and confirmed; and that there be, and is hereby, levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which said assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands, are as follows, to-wit:

And it is hereby determined and declared by thsi Council that said lots and lands are each benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment hereby levied thereon and that said assessments are in proportion to the special benefits.

Section 2. That the total assessment against each 1 lot or parcel of land shall be paid in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in nine annual installments with interest at the rate of 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ % per annum, from April 1st, 1928. All cash payments shall be made to the Treasurer of said Village. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and ce from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

 Notice is hereby given that the estimated assessment of the cost of constructing a storm sewer in Clifton Ave. from Alum Creek to a point approximately 300 ft. west of Parkview Ave. on the lots and lands benefited and to be charged therewith as set forth in a resolution to construct said storm sewer, has been made and reported to council and said estimated assessment is now on file in the office of the clerk of the council of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, for the inspection and examination of all persons interested therein.
