

## AN ORDINANCE NO. 942.

To vacate that part of the alley between Cassady Road and Ardmore Road extending from the south line of Dale Avenue to the south line of Lots Numbers Six (6) and Twelve (12) of Bexley Place Addition.

WHEREAS, on the 10th day of April, a petition and consent by persons owning all the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon that part of the alley between Cassady Road and Ardmore Road, from the south line of Dale Avenue to the South line of Lots Numbers Six (6) and Twelve (12) of Bexley Place Addition in said Village, was duly presented to Council praying that said alley between said points be vacated as provided in Section 3727 of the General Code and further requesting that the Village reserve for itself the public and quasi-public corporations holding franchises and permits from the Village for the supply of water, gas, electricity and telephone service all necessary in, under and over said alley-way, to enable the Village and said public and quasi-public corporations to enter upon and use said alley for the purpose of mains, poles, wires and conduits and maintaining and keeping same in repair insofar as the Village may find necessary to supply its habitants with public utility service, sewers and drains, and

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for and that such vacation will not be detrimental to the general interests and finds that said petition and consent have been signed by all of the owners of the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said alley between said points, NOW, THEREFORE:


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That that part of the alley parallel to and between Cassady Road and Ardmore Road, which part extends from the south line of Dale Avenue to the south line of Lots Numbers Six (6) and Twelve (12) of Bexley Place Addition in said Village, be, and the same is hereby, vacated; reserving, however, for the Village, the public and quasi-public corporations holding franchises and

permits from the Village for the supplying of water, gas, electricity and telephone service, all necessary easements in, under and over said part of said alley to enable the village and said public, and quasi-public corporations to enter upon and use said alley for the purpose of installing, maintaining and repairing, sewers, mains, poles, wires and conduits insofar as the Village may determine to be necessary to supply its inhabitants with public utility service, sewers and drainage.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
