

ORDINANCE NO. 961.

Providing for repairing Drexel Avenue between Main Street and Dale Avenue in the Village of Bexley.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Drexel Avenue, between Main Street and Dale Avenue, shall be repaired between and adjacent to the tracks of The Columbus Railway Power & Light Company, by making the necessary repairs to the existing foundation and laying surface of brick upon a sand cushion in accordance with the specifications and estimates prepared by the engineer and on file with the clerk, which specifications and estimates are hereby approved.


Section 2. That the cost of said improvement, estimated by the engineer at \$6,600.00 shall be paid out of the Washington Trust Co Municipal Fund, which amount is hereby appropriated from said fund for that purpose.

Section 3. That the Clerk be, and is hereby, authorized to advertise for bids for said improvement according to law, and the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized on behalf of the Village to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder therefor.

Section 4. That this ordinance is an ^{Ordinance} emergency and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety due to the present dangerous condition of the surface of that part of said street hereinabove described and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.


