

AN ORDINANCE NO. 963.


WHEREAS, in the installation of the lighting system for certain street and avenues pursuant to Ordinance No. 948, duly passed on the 22nd day of May, 1928, it is necessary that the existing equipment now on the poles of the Columbus Railway Power & Light Company on Drexel Avenue, Powell Avenue, and the alley east of Cassingham Road be changed so as to permit the installation of an over head feed line thereon as hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, the said Columbus Railway Power & Light Company have agreed to change such equipment for the sum of \$496.75, and council is of the opinion that said work should be done by said Company and that the same is the cheapest price that it can be obtained, NOW, THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That said The Columbus Railway Power & Light Company, be, and the same is hereby authorized to make the necessary changes of equipment on its poles now located on Drexel Avenue, Powell Avenue and the alley east of Cassingham Road so as to permit the installation of an over head feed line from the existing transformer station now on Main Street to the new transformer station on Cassingham Road, and that said The Columbus Railway Power & Light Company be paid there for the sum of \$496.75 out of the Street Light Fund which amount is hereby appropriated from said fund for that purpose.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


