

AN ORDINANCE NO. 972.

To provide for additional deputy marshal in the Village of Bexley.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That there shall be appointed one deputy marshal in the Village of Bexley in addition to all other deputy marshals heretofore provided for. Said appointment shall be made by the Mayor and subject to the confirmation of Council.

Section 2. The salary of said deputy marshal shall be not to exceed One Hundred Sixty-Five Dollars (\$165.00) per month; and such deputy marshal shall give bond according to law in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety of the Village and shall go into immediate effect.


