ORDINANCE NO. 974.

To vacate that part of the first alley south of Broad Street in the Village of Bexley extending from Øassingham Road to Remington Road.

WHEREAS, on the 13th day of November, 1928, a petition and consent by the persons owning all the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon that part of the first alley south of Broad Street and extending from Cassingham Road to Remington Road, was duly presented to Council, praying that said alley between said points be vacated as provided in Section 3727 of the General Code, and

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for and that such vacation will not be detrimental to the general interests and finds that said petition and consent have been signed by all of the owners of Lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said part of said alley, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That said first alley south of Broad Street between Cassingham Road and Remington Road be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
