

An ordinance No. 1009.

To provide for two additional deputy marshalls in the Village of Bexley,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY,  
STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That there shall be appointed two deputy marshalls in the Village of Bexley in addition to all other deputy marshalls heretofore provided for. Said appointments shall be made by the Mayor and subject to the confirmation of Council.

Section 2. The salary of said deputy marshalls shall be not to exceed One Hundred Sixty-Five Dollars (\$165.00) per month; and such deputy marshalls shall give bond according to law in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety of the Village and shall go into immediate effect.
