

AN ORDINANCE NO. 1012.

Providing for the changing of certain premises on Cassady Road from Class 1, or Single Family House District, to Class 3, or Retail Business District.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the classification of the tier of lots fronting on the east side of Cassady Road between the north corporation line and the north line of Ruhl Avenue and the tier of lots fronting on the west side of Cassady Road from the north corporation line to the north line of Caroline Avenue be and the same are hereby changed from Class 1, or Single Family House District, to Class 3, or Retail Business District, as defined in Ordinance No. 456 providing for the zoning and districting of the Village of Bexley, passed October 23rd, 1923. All provisions and regulations of said Ordinance No. 456 applying to Class 3, or Retail Business District, shall hereby be held applicable to the above defined territory.

Section 2. That the map showing the boundaries of the various districts described in said zoning ordinance No. 456 and made a part of said Ordinance, be changed in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


