AN ORDINANCE NO. 1017.

Remitting in part the assessment against Lot Number

One Hundred and ten (110) of Plaza Addition for the improvement of

Cassingham Road between Main Street and Fair Avenue.

Whereas, by Ordinance No. 982, duly passed on the 25rd day of January, 1929, an assessment was levied against Lot No.110 of Flaza Addition in the Village of Berney, title to said lot appearing in the name of Frances A. Bryan, which said assessment included also an assessment for constructing cement sidewalks in front of said precises, and

Whereas, the Village of Bexley has assumed and agreed with the owner of said premises to pay the cost of said sidewalk construction in the sum of Forty Seven Dollars and Thirty Ceres (\$47.30), NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby remitted from the assessment against Lot No. 110 of Plaza Addition of the Village of Bexley, being the premises located at No. 2419 Havenwood Drive, the sum of Forty Seven Pollars and Thirty Cents (\$47.30) being the amount included in said assessment against said premises for the construction of sidewalks.

Section 2. That the Auditor and Treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio be authorized to deduct said amount of Forty Seven Dollars and Thirty Cents (\$47.50) from said assessment as heretofore certified to the auditor, the remainder to be collected in the manner provided by said Ordinance.

Section 3. The a copy of this Ordinance be certified to the Calling Auditor, Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
