

ORDINANCE NO. 1021.

Determining to proceed with the construction of an intercepting sanitary sewer, without regard to sewer districts, in Livingston Avenue to furnish an additional outlet for the sewers of Districts Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, and 6.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the construction of an intercepting sanitary sewer in Livingston Avenue from a point beginning at the end of the existing 36 inch sewer approximately 50 feet east of the east line of College Avenue and extending westerly to the east bank of Alum Creek, a distance of approximately _____ feet, said sewer so to be constructed being a portion of the intercepting sanitary sewer designed to furnish an additional outlet for the system of sewers heretofore adopted and installed in Districts Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, and 6 in said Village, the same ultimately to be extended to and connected with the trunk Sewer in the City of Columbus, now under construction and designated as Sewerage & Sewage Disposal Contract No. 1, Alum Creek Intercepting Sewer, Section No. 1, according to the plans and specifications prepared by the engineers and now on file in the office of the Clerk, and shall be 27 and 33 inches in diameter and constructed of vitrified pipe, segment block, or concrete, in accordance with a Resolution No. 784, declaring it necessary to make said improvement, adopted June 11th, 1929.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting from said improvement shall be judicially inquired into after the completion of the improvement, and the solicitor is hereby authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

Section 3. That the entire cost of said improvement shall be paid by the Village, and the cost of said improvement shall include the expense of preliminary and other surveys, the printing and publishing of notices, resolutions and ordinances required, the serving of such notices, the cost of construction and all other

necessary expenditures. Said cost shall be paid from the proceeds of bonds of said Village issued in the manner provided by law, provided however, the notes of said Village may be issued and sold in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds.

Section 4. That the Clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
