AN ORDINANCE NO. 1023

Accepting easement for sever over lands of Minard Holtzman.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY; STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the grant of a right of way and easement for sanitary sewer over and through the following described real catate, to-wit:-

First Parcel:

Beirs, a strip of ground 10 feet in width, 5 feet on each side, of the following described center line;-

Beginning at a point in the north line of Livingston Avenue 26 feet east of a cross on the north wing of the east abutment of the bridge over Alum Creek, said cross being the same as shown in Minard Holtzman's Mayfield Place Subdivision, as the same is shown of record in Plat Bock 11, Page 20, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio; thence northerly with a line perpendicular to the north line of Livingston Avenue 123.5 feet to a point in Lot No.51 of Minard Holtzman's Mayfield Place Subdivision.

Second Parcel:

Bei also a strip of ground 15 feet in width, 7.5 feet on each side of the following described center line:-

Beginning at a point in the west line of the above described 10-foot easement, said point being 116 feet north of the north line of Livingston Avenue; thence west and parallel with the north line of Livingston avenue 106 feet, more or less, to the center line of Alum Creek,

executed in favor of the Village of Bexley by Minard Holtzman, bearing date of August 23rd, 1929, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the Clerk is directed to cause sale easement to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
