
To amend Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1001 creating the position and providing for the appointment of a forester in the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1001 creating the position and providing for the appointment of a forester in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, passed April 16th, 1929, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:-

Section 2. Said appointment shall be at the pleasure of the Mayor, but shall not exceed the period of eight (8) months in any one year, and the salary shall not exceed Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) per month during the term of service.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and shall go into immediate force and effect.
