## ORDINANCE NO. 1033.

Establishing curb grades on East Broad Street, between the west corporation line and the east corporation line of the Village of Bexley, Ohio

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUXLAY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the curb grade or elevation of the north and south curbs, respectively, on East Broad Street, between the west corporation line and the east corporation line in the Village of Benley be, and they are hereby established as follows, to-wit:-

Beginning at station 0.00 at a point in the cast edge of the bridge over Alum Creek, said point being 2370 ft. west of the center line of Parkview Avenue, and at elevation 83.37; thence easterly with a reversed vertical curve as follows:
